Most of our TES families fall in the average amount for both grants and awards. This would mean out-of-pocket costs for The Edison School would be \$8,625 for the school year. We know a lot of different factors are considered with both grant awards so these numbers are just to help you decide if you think you can afford The Edison School. You need to be prepared to pay at least 36% of our annual tuition, most families will pay more. This 36% would be only if you qualified for the highest amount of IEA Grant awards and Financial Aid Awards.
